Abstract:

The scrapbook contains newspaper clippings primarily related to the military from WWII through the 1950s, particularly the U.S. Army and Army Air Corps.

Biographical / Historical Notes:

There is no information as to the creator of this scrapbook.

The Army Air Service started in 1918, and in 1926 became the Army Air Corps. In 1941, it changed its name to the US Army Air Forces in 1947 and became the modern US Air Force.

Lt. Gen. Delos Emmons transferred to the Army Air Service in 1920 until his retirement in 1948.

Scope and Content:

The scrapbook contains newspaper clippings primarily related to the military from WWII through the 1950s, particularly the U.S. Army and Army Air Corps.

Lt. Gen. Delos Emmons is prominent in many of the articles. Major Reuben H. Fleet and Edsel Ford are also mentioned. Also included are articles on the sinking of the Bismarck and the Hood, as well as the Consolidated Aircraft Co. (Consair) and the building of the first 1,000 mph jet, the F8U Crusader. Some of the articles are in Japanese and appear to be from internment camp newsletters. The scrapbook also contains some original photographs of unidentified people at "Moulin Rouge" at Hollywood, and information on baseball player, Lou Gehrig and his death.

Arrangement:

The scrapbook appears to be arranged chronologically.

Condition and Preservation:

The scrapbook was deconstructed to aid its long-time preservation.

The condition of the scrapbook is poor. Newspapers clippings are discolored and many contain glue marks although the pages remain relatively undamaged.
