Abstract:

This scrapbook pertains to Boy Scout Troop 52, a youth group of The Ocean View Church of Christ.

Biography/History:

Between 1920 and the outbreak of World War II, the Ocean View Church of Christ expanded both its programs and services including creating a youth group, Boy Scout Troop 52. John Yamamoto was the Scoutmaster, and there was a corresponding Girl Scout Troop 8, led by Troop Captain Mae Otsuka.

There is no evidence to suggest who created this scrapbook, but it was possibly put together as a troop project. The photographs near the end are attributed to James Suzuki.

Scope and Content:

This scrapbook pertains to Boy Scout Troop 52, a youth group of The Ocean View Church of Christ. It contains information and photographs on events as well as records of troop members. Included are newspaper articles related to Troop 52 as well as other local troops.

Arrangement:

The scrapbook has been retained in its original order.

Condition and Preservation:

This scrapbook is in good condition although some of the newspaper clippings are showing discoloration.
